National Institute of Siddha (NIS), an autonomous body under the Ministry of Ayush, Government of India is a premier institution in the Siddha System of Medicine conducting Post Graduate Programmes and Research in varied branches of Siddha. This Institute also provides the best quality treatment and medicines to more than 2000 outpatients and 200 inpatients regularly, through its attached Ayothidoss Pandithar Hospital, which is also NABH accredited. In addition to the above, this Institute is also conducting outreach camps and OPDs in urban, semi-urban, rural and tribal areas.

NIS plans to conduct a Public Health Intervention (PHI) project in the Madurai and Theni Districts of Tamil Nadu. For this purpose, this Institute intends to engage the services of a NABL accredited laboratory for conducting the following laboratory investigations on patients/subjects recruited under the above project, for which competitive quotations are invited:

1. Complete Blood Count (CBC) - [Haemoglobin, Total WBC Count, Differential Count, HCT/PCV, MCV, MCH, MCHC, Platelet Count, Total RBC Count]
2. Serum Ferritin
3. Smear Study
4. Folic Acid

Salient features of the project are as follows:

- Duration of the project : 3 years
- Project Location: Madurai District and Theni District

- The number of samples for which laboratory investigation has to be conducted: 1500 patients/subjects (approx.) x 2 times (before and after treatment) = 3000 samples (approx.)

Scope of Services of the engaged laboratories are as follows:

1. The laboratory concerned should make arrangements for sending Laboratory Technicians to the spot where the camp/screening centre is conducted for the collection of samples.
2. The venue for the sample collection will be intimated to the laboratory through the Project Manager/Specialist at least two days before the commencement of the camp/screening centre
3. Results of the tests must be submitted within 24 hours of sample collection.
4. Both hardcopy and softcopy of the results must be submitted. The softcopy of the test result must be sent to the official mail ID of the PHI project. Hardcopy may be handed over to the Project Manager/Specialist at the camp location or PHI Project office.

You are requested to quote your lowest rates for conducting the above tests. Rates may be quoted for individual tests. Rates may be quoted in the following format:


