#### 1. Introduction

The Siddha system of medicine has evolved with the civilizations of Mohenjadaro and Harappa in the Indus valley around 10,000 years ago. This is a contribution of the Dravidian culture, which is one of the oldest cultures, to the world. This system is said to have developed mainly by 18 Siddhars out of which the great Sage Agasthiyar is considered as the Father of Siddha Medicine. Thirumoolar, the first disciple of Agasthiyar, is believed to have taken lifetime efforts for nurturing the growth and development of the Siddha system of medicine. This system is following unique methods in preventing, treating, and restoring the health of patients. The Siddha system of medicine relies on the concepts of moral principles such as *Naalozhukkam* and moral guidance such as *Pini Anugavidhi* which is extremely relevant to our current health care system to prevent people from various life-threatening Communicable and Non–Communicable diseases. During the Covid-19 Pandemic the Siddha system of medicine was able to save the lives a number of acute, moderate and mild Covid patients through the timely application of preventive and curative medicines available in the system. The basic principle of this system is "*Unave Marunthu, Marunthe Unavu*", means "*Food is Medicine and Medicine is Food*".

#### 2. About National institute of Siddha:

The National Institute of Siddha (NIS), Chennai is the only National Institute for Siddha system of medicine set up by the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India during 2005. The institution was dedicated to the Nation on 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2005. The Institute is striving to be a Centre of Excellence in the Siddha system of Medicine by offering Post Graduate courses (PG) and Ph.D. programmes in 8 Siddha disciplines. The Institute is also providing affordable medical care through the Ayothidoss Pandithar Hospital attached to it. The Institute undertakes several measures to promote and propagate the Siddha system of medicine. The Institute is conducting special OPDs, a tribal OPD at Kothimangalam village, Chengalpattu District and Swasthya Rakshan OPD. Swasthya Parikshan camps are being conducted at 5 places in Chengalpattu and Kanchipuram districts. This institute is taking steps to develop a curriculum to integrate the traditional science with modern science. Various research projects are underway in this Institute to validate the efficacy and safety of the Siddha formulations to enhance their acceptability.

This Institute is affiliated to The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai and it follows the syllabus and curriculum approved by the National Council of Indian System of Medicine (NCISM). The Institute is conducting M.D Siddha programmes in 8 specialties and Ph.D programmes in 6 Specialties. During 2022-23 the NCISM has given approval to start the Bachelor of Siddha Medicine and Surgery (BSMS) programme with an intake of 60 seats. The Institute is also conducting various research projects, internship programmes, teachers training programmes, seminars and workshops from time to time.

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# 6. General Instructions

1	The candidates should read all the instructions given in this Prospectus and Application Form carefully before filling up the Application Form
2	Fill up the Application Form carefully and legibly without overwriting. Use blue or black ball point pen only. Application Form prepared using computers can also be submitted
3	NEET-2022 Admit Card Number and marks scored in NEET-2022 have to be filled up in the relevant columns in the Application Form.
4	Photocopies of all the certificates and other documents enclosed with the Application Form should be self-attested by the Candidate. Original documents including the NEET-2022 Score Card showing the Percentile Score and NEET-2022 Admit Card should be produced at the time of admission to the programme.
5	Filled up application forms with enclosures may be sent by Speed Post / Courier so as to reach The Director, National Institute of Siddha, Tambaram Sanatorium, Chennai -600 047, Tamil Nadu, India on or before 27 <sup>th</sup> January 2023 by 5.00 pm. This Institute will not be responsible for any Postal/Courier delay.

# 7. Eligibility for admission

	Admission will be conducted based on the NEET-2022 Score, reservation norms of Govt. of

- Candidates who have been made ineligible by AACCC, due to their non-reporting to previous rounds of counseling / any other reasons are not eligible to get admission to the BSMS programme conducted by this Institute.
- Candidates should have studied Tamil as one of the subjects in the 10<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> Standard. Candidates who have not studied Tamil shall have to study Tamil as an additional subject during the First Professional B.S.M.S session for 18 months
- 4 The candidate should be a citizen of India (Not applicable to students from foreign countries)

#### 8. Method of Admission

1.

- a. The Merit List of candidates will be prepared based on the NEET Score and reservation norms of Govt. of India the candidates.
- b. It will be published in the Institute website.
- c. The **First 30 candidates** in the merit list will be instructed to report to the Institute with the originals of all the relevant documents on **03.02.2023**. Candidates who fail to report for admission on the above-mentioned date will forfeit their right to admission to the BSMS programme of this Institute.
- d. If any seats are lying vacant after 03.02.2023 the required number of candidates, on the basis of the Merit List and reservation norms of Govt. of India, will be directed to report on **06.02.2023**.
- e. To fill up any more vacant seats the last round of admission will be conducted on **07.02.2023** in which the required number of candidates, starting from the next eligible candidate in the Merit List after the last candidate reported on 06.02.2023, plus the next 5 eligible candidates in the list, will be instructed to report. However, the seats will be allotted to the candidates only based on the Merit List and reservation norms of the Govt. of India.
- f. The Vacancy List will be published in the Institute website every day till the admission is closed.
- g. The admission process will be closed on 07.02.2023.
- h. The last date to discontinue the course by the selected candidates would be 10.02.2023.
- i. After 10.02.2023 if any candidate discontinue the programme he/she will have to pay a penalty of Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) for leaving the course.
  - The fees paid by them at the time of admission to the BSMS programme of this Institute would also be forfeited in such cases.
- Requests for extension of time to join or change of date of admission will not be accepted in any case.

If the candidate fails to report to the Institute for attending the classes after joining the BSMS programme by paying the prescribed fees, the amount of fees paid by the candidate at the time of admission to the BSMS programme of this Institute would be forfeited. In addition the candidate will have to pay a penalty of Rs. 2,50,000/- (Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand only)

#### 10. Additional instructions to fill up reservation category seats

- 1. SC / ST Candidates should produce valid Community Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- 2. OBC Candidates shall produce valid OBC Certificate showing their exclusion from Creamy Layer for the year 2022-23 as per the Govt. of India Notifications issued from time to time.
- 3. SC/ST/OBC candidates selected against UR seats have to submit their community certificate at the time of admission as per the AACCC norms for admission for the Academic Year 2022-23, failing which their admission cannot be processed in the system.
- 4. EWS Candidates should produce Income and Asset Certificate issued by a competent authority in the prescribed format as given in Annexure-I of the OM No.36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) dated31<sup>st</sup>January, 2019 issued by Department of personnel & Training.

#### 11. Interchange of Reserved seats

- 1. If the seats reserved for ST category remain unfilled due to non-availability of eligible candidates, the same would be filled up from the candidates belonging to the SC category on the basis of merit.
- 2. If the seats reserved for EWS category remain unfilled due to non-availability of eligible candidates, the same would be filled up from the candidates belonging to the UR category on the basis of merit.

#### 12. Fees Payable

- 1. Cost of Application Form Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) (SC/ST/PwD Candidates are exempted from payment of Application Fee)
- 2. Course Fee Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) payable on the date of admission to the BSMS Programme.
- 3. Thereafter the Course Fee has to be paid in 2 (Two) Installments of Rs. 25000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) each during 1<sup>st</sup> January and 1<sup>st</sup> July of every year. If 1<sup>st</sup> January/July happens to be a holiday the fee is to be remitted on the next working day.
- 4. Refundable Caution Deposit Every Candidate joining the BSMS programme has to pay a refundable caution deposit of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only). The amount will be refunded to the student upon completion/discontinuation of the BSMS programme. The student has to submit a Non-Liability Certificate from all the Departments/Sections/Offices of the Institute to get the refund of the Caution Deposit. If the student commits any activity that may lead to damage/loss to any object/property belonging to the Institute, the cost of the object/property will be recovered from the refundable Caution Deposit. If that amount is not sufficient to meet the cost involved, the student will have to pay the additional amount involved in such cases to the Institute.
- 5. Students who have passed their +2 Course or equivalent from other States shall have to submit their Migration Certificate and Eligibility Certificate (to be obtained from The Tamil Nadu Dr.MGR Medical University) to this Institute. Instructions and method of obtaining the above certificates from the University will be issued to the candidates upon joining the BSMS programme.
- 6. Examination fees as prescribed by The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University from time-to-time will be collected from the students along with the Examination Application Form to be submitted to the University.

#### 13. Fine/Re-admission Fee for Delayed payment of Course Fee

- 1. Notices will be issued by the Academic Section during last week of December and June every year for payment of the course fee.
- 2. The candidates can pay the First/Second Installment of the course fee till the last working day of every January/July.
- 3. After the above date the student will not be given attendance and he will also not be permitted to appear in the University Examination. The period of absence on this account will be treated as discontinuation/unauthorized absence and will be governed as per the rules specified in point No. 18.

4. The fees prescribed above would be subject to revision from time-to-time.

## 14. Stipend

Stipend will be paid to the BSMS students during their Internship period of the programme as notified by the Institute from time to time.

#### 15. Vacation

The students will be having the following periods of vacation:

- 1. **Summer Vacation**: 30 days in the month of May during every Academic Year.
- 2. Winter Vacation: 15 days in the month of December during every Academic Year.
- 3. The Circulars granting vacation will be issued annually by the Institute.

#### 16. Attendance:

Attendance in practical and theory classes as prescribed by the University and NCISM for appearing in the University examinations is mandatory.

#### 17. Anti-Ragging Policy

The clauses of the regulations of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University with regard to ragging are followed strictly in this Institute to implement the Anti Ragging measures.

Each student and his/her parent have to submit a written undertaking in this respect during every academic year. The same undertaking is also to be submitted online every year in the website <a href="www.antiragging.in/Site/Affidavits\_Registration.aspx">www.antiragging.in/Site/Affidavits\_Registration.aspx</a> to fulfill the online compliance of anti ragging regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational Institutions.

## 18. Course Discontinuation / Unauthorised Absence

- 1. Absence of a student for more than 30 days without prior permission / without intimation to the Institute will be treated as 'discontinuation of the course'. Such student will stand terminated automatically from the BSMS programme without any notice.
- 2. The break in study period upto three months can be condoned by the Director, National Institute of Siddha.
- 3. If the break in study period is more than 3 months but less than 18 months, the candidate should apply to the University through this Institute for condonation of the break in study.
- 4. If the break period exceeds 18 months, the candidate will be discharged from the course for which he/she has to pay a penalty of Rs.2,5,00,00/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand only). The fees paid by him/her till the date of discontinuation will also be forfeited.
- 5. If the candidate is debarred from the course for any reasons, he/she has to pay a penalty of Rs.2,5,00,00/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand only). The fees paid by him/her till the date of discontinuation will also be forfeited.

- 6. In addition to the above, the Institute shall adopt any notification issued by The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University from time-to-time in this regard.
- 7. Any student discontinuing the BSMS course beyond 10.02.2023 and before the commencement of the classes shall have to pay the penalty of Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand only). The fees paid by him/her till the date of discontinuation will also be forfeited.

#### 19. Bond

The candidates joining the BSMS Programme of this Institute should submit a **Notarised Bond**, in Rs. 100/- (Rupees One Hundred only) Stamp Paper, in the prescribed format as given in the Annexure to this Prospectus.

#### 20. Research, Seminars and Extension Activities

Every student shall participate/present papers in the workshops/ seminars conducted in the Institute or University level. Departmental seminars will be regularly conducted and eminent scholars / medical experts would be invited to deliver guest lectures for exchange of views. All students have to compulsorily participate in such seminars and conferences.

Books and instruments provided for the use of the stipendiary during the course of studies shall remain the property of National Institute of Siddha, represented by the Director, who may however permit the students to retain the instrument and text books.

- 1. The students shall strictly adhere to the instructions given in the Prospectus of the Bachelor Siddha Medicine and Surgery (BSMS) Programme for the academic year 2022-23.
- 2. The stipend is payable only after verification of attendance and on recommendation based on satisfactory performances and progress of the students by the respective H.O.D.
- 3. During the period of the U.G. studies at the National Institute of Siddha, he/she will not be allowed to do any type of job outside the Institute.
- 4. The students shall attend Clinical /academic / Research work allotted by the Director, Heads of Departments or Hospital Superintendent. They are also bound to participate in Arogya fairs, camps etc as deputed by Director or his / her representative.
- 5. The grievances if any can be redressed through Heads of the Departments and the Director, and as such formation of students' union shall not be permitted.
- 6. If his/her admission is cancelled for any reason by the Director, National Institute of Siddha, Tambaram Sanatorium, Chennai-47 before completion of the course, he/she shall repay the entire amount of stipend, if any, received by him/her from the Institute along with the penalty of Rs.2,50,000 (Rupees Two lakhs Fifty Thousand only)
- 7. Upon allotment of the Hostel facilities, none other than the inmates of the hostel will be permitted to stay in the hostel.
- 8. The decision of the Director will be final in all the matters concerning this Institute.

- 9. University fees, Examination fees and the course fee have to be paid on time by the student without fail.
- 10. U.G Scholars are not permitted to host/attend any Party etc., in the campus without prior permission.
- 11. In case of discontinuation of course on any cause including personal reasons or any other recruitment /appointment during the U.G Course he /she has to repay the entire stipend, if any, received up to the date of relief of U.G studies along with a penalty of Rs.2,50,000 (Rupees Two lakhs Fifty Thousand only). The candidate shall not have any right for readmission.
- 12. Any student discontinuing the course will not be eligible for readmission. In the event of sudden demise of a student during the study no recovery of penalty shall be made by the Institute.
- 13. The Director, National Institute of Siddha, Tambaram Sanatorium, Chennai-47 shall have the power to suspend or withdraw any stipend if the holder of it misbehaves or shows any unwanted affairs or is likely to be debarred from the studies on any account.
