

Hospital, Tambram, Sanatorium, Chennai, Tamil Nadu- 600047, on seeking permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian system of Medicine, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine to establish new Siddha Medical college in the name of National Institute of Siddha, Trichy Hwy, Near Govt. Hospital, Tambram, Sanatorium, Chennai, Tamil Nadu- 600047 (Inst. ID- SID0272), with 60 seats (Including EWS) in UG (BSMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, and to grant Conditional Permission for conducting 58 PG seats in 08 PG courses namely i) Maruthuvam- 08 seats (Including EWS- 10) ii) Noi-Nadal - 07 seats (Including EWS- 9) iii) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam- 08 seats (Including EWS- 10) iv) Varma Maruthuvam- 03 seats (Including EWS- 3) vi) Gunapadam- 08 seats (Including EWS- 3) vii) Gunapadam- 08 seats (Including EWS- 10) viii) Nanju Maruthuvam- 07 seats (Including EWS- 9) for the academic session 2022-23 -reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am dire cited to inform you that in pursuance of the provisions of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government notified that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. In view of the above the Central Government constituted the Autonomous Boards with effect from 11th June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- I am to refer to your application, on the subject cited above and to verify the available facilities of teaching and practical training for the intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BSMS) Course from the academic session 2022-23, the college has been visited on 19.09.2022 and 20.09.2022 through hybrid mode for LOI by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) and as per direction of competent authority letter of intent has been issued you vide letter No. 1820-01/2022-23-SR (MARB) Dated 21.10.2022 to establish a New Siddha college in the name of National Institute of Siddha, Trichy Hwy, Near Govt. Hospital, Tambram, Sanatorium, Chennai, Tamil Nadu- 600047 (Inst. ID- SID0272), with 60 seats in UG (BSMS) course from the academic session 2022-23 under Section 29 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
- 2. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had carried out an inspection of the institution again on Hybrid mode on 29.11.2022 & 30.11.2022 for Letter of Permission (LOP) and to assess the available facilities of teaching and practical training for establishing new college in the name of National Institute of Siddha, Trichy Hwy, Near Govt. Hospital, Tambram, Sanatorium, Chennai, Tamil Nadu- 600047 (Inst. ID- SID0272), with 60 seats in UG (BSMS) course from the academic section 2022-23 under session 29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
- 3. In view of above as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report and all other related documents were placed in the 24th Board Meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) dated 16.12.2022. Board discussed the same and recommended to issue letter of Permission for intake capacity with 60 seats (Including EWS) in UG (BSMS) course from academic session 2022-23 under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 and to grant Conditional Permission for conducting 58 PG seats in 08 PG courses namely i) Maruthuvam—08 seats (Including EWS- 10) ii) Noi-Nadal 07 seats (Including EWS- 9) iii) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam—08 seats (Including EWS- 10) iv) Varma Maruthuvam—03 seats (Including EWS- 4) v) Yoga Maruthuvam—02 seats (Including EWS- 3) vi) Pura Maruthuvam—03 seats (Including EWS- 3) vii) Gunapadam—08 seats (Including EWS- 10) viii) Nanju Maruthuvam—07 seats (Including EWS- 9) for the academic session 2022-23 on the basis of undertaking vide letter no. NIS/1-34/UG Course/2019, NIS/4-2/Aca/Sel.2021-22, Employment Notification Vide letter no. NIS/1-42/Recruitment-Contract/2022 dated 15.12.2022 submitted by the Director, National Institute of Siddha, Trichy Hwy, Near Govt. Hospital, Tambram, Sanatorium, Chennai, Tamil Nadu-600047.

- 4. Therefore, it has been decided by the president, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) to issue Letter of Permission (LOP) to National Institute of Siddha, Trichy Hwy, Near Govt. Hospital, Tambram, Sanatorium, Chennai, Tamil Nadu- 600047 (Inst. ID- SID0272), with 60 seats (Including EWS) in UG (BSMS) course from the academic session 2022-23 under Section 29 of NCISM ACT 2020 and to grant Conditional Permission for conducting 58 PG seats in 08 PG courses namely i) Maruthuvam- 08 seats (Including EWS- 10) ii) Noi-Nadal 07 seats (Including EWS- 9) iii) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam- 08 seats (Including EWS- 10) iv) Varma Maruthuvam- 03 seats (Including EWS- 4) v) Yoga Maruthuvam- 02 seats (Including EWS- 3) vii) Pura Maruthuvam- 03 seats (Including EWS- 3) vii) Gunapadam- 08 seats (Including EWS- 10) viii) Nanju Maruthuvam- 07 seats (Including EWS- 9) for the academic session 2022-23 and relevant regulations thereunder. Subject to the condition that following conditions:-
  - I. It is further informed that 50% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BSMS) course and 58 PG seats (Including EWS) in 08 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government/ NCISM for 2022-23. The Permission of the College stands withdrawn if the College fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- 5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 6. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2022 to get permission for the session 2023-24:
  - i. The applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of infrastructure for teaching and training facilities as specified in "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016.
  - ii. The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions of Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2016 (for Siddha);
  - iii. The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020.
- 7. The College administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requicite staff in the hospital, as per the NCISM ACT and relevant regulation thereunder, are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1<sup>st</sup> professional of BSMS is made, under intimation to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM.
- 8. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for I, II and III professionals well in time as per the norms which will be verified by the medical assessment and rating board and accordingly the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be considered.
- The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 35 of the NC ISM act 2020 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
- 10. The fulfillment of the condition given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to medical assessment and rating board for Indian system of medicine. The medical assessment and rating board for Indian system of medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2022-23.
