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Responsibilities of the Pharmacovigilance Centres:

Intermediary Pharmacovigilance Centres (IPvCs):

The IPvCS of the respective systems (Ayurveda / Siddha / Unani / Homoeopathy) shall i) Document and monitor the ADRs of ASU&H drugs ii) Collect the information regarding the ADRs of ASU&H drugs from the respective Peripheral Pharmacovigilance Centre (PPvCS) iii) Report the ADRs of ASU&H drugs to the National Pharmacovigilance Centre (NPvCC) at regular intervals for casualty assessment. iv) organize awareness building and capacity building workshops for the stakeholders v) Scrutinize the project proposals received from the Peripheral Pharmacovigilance Centres(PPvCs) and forward the same to the National Pharmacovigilance Centre (NPvCC) along with comments.

Responsibilities of the Research Associate:

1. The selected candidates will be engaged under the project of Central Sector Scheme of Augmenting Quality of Ayush Drugs – Ayush Oushadhi Gunvatta Evam Utpadan Samvardhan Yojana (AOGUSY).
2. To co-ordinate and liaison with officers of National Pharmacovigilance Co-ordination Centre, Intermediary Pharmacovigilance Centre and Peripheral Pharmacovigilance Centres.
3. To update and provide regular status reports of the program as required.
4. To assist in organizing the training program and developing IEC materials under the scheme.
5. other related activities assigned from time to time.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. M.D(S) / BSMS degree should be duly recognized NCISM. Preference will be given to persons already working in Central Sector Schemes of Ayush. Working knowledge of MS office, MS Word, MS Excel, MS Power Point is desirable.
2. The appointment will be purely based on candidates performance and purely temporary. It is co-terminus with the project the appointment for the above post will be initially for 1 year and further extended based on the approval of project scheme and the satisfactory performance of the incumbent.
