Subject:- Grant of Yearly Permission to National Institute of Siddha, Trichy Hwy, near Government Hospital, Tambaram Sanatorium, Chennai, Tamil Nadu 600047 (Institutional ID - SID0272), for issuance of Yearly permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BSMS) course and Extended Permission with intake capacity of 58 seats in 09 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Maruthuvam- 10 seats (ii) Gunapadam Marunthiyal- 05 seats (iii) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam-10 seats (iv) Noi-Nadal-09 seats (v) Pura Maruthuvam (External Therapy)-03 seats (vi) Siddhar Yoga Maruthuvam (Siddhar's Yogic Science-03 seats (vii) Varma Maruthuvam (Varma Medicine)-04 seats (viii) Gunapadam Marunthakaviyal- 05 (ix) Nanju Maruthuvam-09 seats for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) This is with reference to the visitation of your college namely National Institute of Siddha, Trichy Hwy, near Government Hospital, Tambaram Sanatorium, Chennai, Tamil Nadu 600047 (Institutional ID - SID0272) conducted on 04.06.2026 and 05.06.2026 in hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process Permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BSMS) course and Extended Permission with intake capacity of 58 seats in 09 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Maruthuvam- 10 seats (ii) Gunapadam Marunthiyal- 05 seats (iii) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam-10 seats (iv) Noi-Nadal-09 seats (v) Pura Maruthuvam (External Therapy)-03 seats (vi) Siddhar Yoga Maruthuvam (Siddhar's Yogic Science-03 seats (vii) Varma Maruthuvam (Varma Medicine)-04 seats (viii) Gunapadam Marunthakaviyal- 05 (ix) Nanju Maruthuvam-09 seats for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
- 2) Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations, namely, "Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Siddha colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024" and "Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for postgraduate Siddha colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024" provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. On careful examination of the assessment report shortcomings/defects were observed and same was placed in the 174th Board meeting of MARBSIM held on 25.07.2026 and Board decided to provide an opportunity of Hearing to your college.
- 3) In view of above an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBSIM letter (Hearing notice) of even no. 18-7/2026-27/SID/MARB dated 03.09.2026 was granted to your college to appear on 08.09.2026 before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to why not the permission to your college with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BSMS) course and 58 seats in 09 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Maruthuvam- 10 seats (ii) Gunapadam Marunthiyal- 05 seats (iii) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam-10 seats (iv) Noi-Nadal-09 seats (v) Pura Maruthuvam (External Therapy)-03 seats (vi) Siddhar Yoga Maruthuvam (Siddhar's Yogic Science-03 seats (vii) Varma Maruthuvam (Varma Medicine)-04 seats (viii) Gunapadam Marunthakaviyal- 05 (ix) Nanju Maruthuvam-09 seats for the academic session 2026-27, under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 be reassessed as per Punitive policy.

- 4) Thereafter, an undertaking-cum-affidavit vide no. FH143988 dated 08.09.2026 submitted by Prof. Dr. G. Senthilvel, Director, National Institute of Siddha, Trichy Hwy, near Government Hospital, Tambaram Sanatorium, Chennai, Tamil Nadu to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) ensuring that the deficiencies and shortcomings observed regarding Teaching, Non-Teaching and Hospital Staff shall be fulfilled on or before 31st January 2027.
- 5) Further, it is decided that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the concerned Acts and Regulations to issue the yearly permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BSMS) course and Extended Permission with intake capacity of 58 seats in 09 PG courses under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27 subject to ratification in the ensuing Board Meeting.

"DECISION"

- 6) Therefore, in view of above, National Institute of Siddha, Trichy Hwy, near Government Hospital, Tambaram Sanatorium, Chennai, Tamil Nadu 600047 (SID0272) is hereby granted with Yearly Permission in UG (BSMS) course with intake capacity of 60 seats in accordance with Regulation 60 (1) (a) of MESAR UG Siddha 2024 and Extended Permission with intake capacity of 58 seats in 09 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Maruthuvam- 10 seats (ii) Gunapadam Marunthiyal- 05 seats (iii) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam-10 seats (iv) Noi-Nadal-09 seats (v) Pura Maruthuvam (External Therapy)-03 seats (vi) Siddhar Yoga Maruthuvam (Siddhar's Yogic Science-03 seats (vii) Varma Maruthuvam (Varma Medicine)-04 seats (viii) Gunapadam Marunthakaviyal- 05 (ix) Nanju Maruthuvam-09 seats in accordance with regulation 16(5)(a) of MESAR PG Siddha 2024 for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
- 7) The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-
- (i) Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity 60 seats in UG (BSMS) course and minimum 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 58 seats in 09 PG Courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counselling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2026-27 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- 8) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 9) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 10) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 11) **Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. Ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
- 12) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2026 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2027-2028:-**
- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
- ii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Siddha Education) Regulations-2022.
- iii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate & Postgraduate Siddha Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.

- 13) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2027-28.
